## SAFETY INSTRUCTION'S

- Please advise the property manager that you may need assistance if the building was to be evacuated, as there will be no elevator service. This will allow the property manager to plan and make the necessary arrangements on your behalf. Please call the Concierge staff at 778-328-9059 if you need assistance.
- Turn off all tools, appliances and electronic equipment, and turn the thermostat(s) for the home heating system down to minimum to prevent damage from a power surge when power is restored. Also, power can be restored more easily when there is not a heavy load on the electrical system.
- Turn off all lights, except one inside and one outside (if applicable), so that both you and hydro crews outside know that power has been restored.
- Don't open your freezer or fridge unless it is absolutely necessary. A full freezer will keep food frozen for 24 to 36 hours if the door remains closed. try not to open your refrigerator or freezer doors so you don't lose cold air unnecessarily. The contents of a full fridge should keep for about six hours; the contents of a full freezer should last for as long as two days. Don't taste foods to see whether they're OK. Instead, follow these rules: Throw away any food items that become warmer than 41 degrees. And if you're in doubt about a food item, throw it out.
- Never use charcoal or gas barbecues, camping heating equipment, or home generators indoor. They give off carbon monoxide. Because you can't smell or see it, carbon monoxide can cause health problems and is life-threatening.
- Use proper candleholders. Never leave lit candles unattended and keep out of reach of children. Always extinguish candles before going to bed.
- Give the electrical system a chance to stabilize before reconnecting tools and appliances. Wait 10 to 15 minutes before reconnecting fridge and stove then reconnect all other tools and appliances.
- Reset your clocks, automatic timers, and alarms.
